MATTER OF APEX BENEFITS

APEX was in attendance to explain more on the health insurance. They handed out a 2023-2024 County Premium Equivalent document, Total current cost document and the Benefit Renewal Report. Discussion took place over the documents between APEX and DeKalb County Commissioners.

Todd Sanderson made a motion to approve the 2023-2024 Insurance Employee renewal through APEX with the Surest Plan through United Healthcare modeling of Proposal 8 on page 8 on the Benefit Renewal Report that includes \$100,000 specific deductible and choosing to reduce the Employee contribution by 50% from the current PPO rates, maximum out-of-pocket for single \$5,000/\$10,000 and family \$10,000/\$20,000, keeping the spousal carve-out and including the option to take dental and vision coverage. Michael Watson seconded and all approved.

MATTER OF HIGHWAY

Ben brought to the Commissioners attention an issue with Surf Internet in the County as they have not followed their permit of boring all of their lines and have caused several issues around the County. Ben has stopped the company at this time at CR 28 and CR 31 and had a discussion with them; they also did not have the correct paperwork with them on site. Surf Internet is acceptable at this time to a Hold Harmless Agreement in case the County would hit the conduit when future work is needed. Commissioner Watson does not have a problem with a Hold Harmless Agreement but because there are increasing requests that an inspector should be requested in the 2024 budget between the Highway and Surveyors Department to monitor these permits. Ben also feels there needs to be a fee and penalty for not following the permitting requirements. Attorney Kruse will prepare the Hold Harmless Agreement.

Misc. Topics: Calcium started but is moving slow with the cold overnight temperatures, CR 54 is schedule for first week of June for full depth restoration

MATTER OF BRIDGE #132 ON COUNTY RD 72 ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

Bridge #132 has right of entry request for the 4-corners of the bridge and has not received any response from the landowners. Ben discussed with the County Attorney and DeKalb County Drainage Board and has found out the Metcalf Ditch is regulated by Allen County and is going in front of the Allen County Drainage Board on June 1st, and there is not speculation of any issues in the approval.

Todd Sanderson made a motion for Ben to proceed with the advertising of Request for Bid on Bridge #132 due in the Auditors office by 10:00 on June 19, 2023 to be opened the same day at 10:30 and to be awarded on June 26, 2023. Michael Watson seconded and all approved.
