APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Amendment to the Grant, the amount should be \$61,500, not \$65,000. Judge Brown moved the accept the minutes as amended: Seconded, by Mayor Yoder. Approved.

REPORT OF OFFICERS:

Tim Baker submitted his resignation as Chairman of the Board due to him now being employed by DeKalb County Community Corrections in a full time position. Replacing Lonnie Lanning, who left for other employment. There was also discussion on the appointment of Chairman and Vice Chairman. This matter was tabled until next meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

Kellie stated that the Advisory Board had transferred funds to purchase nine (9) new PC's for student at the CHANGE Academy at a cost of \$388.02 each. Due to the increase in price they were only able to purchase seven (8) new PC's for \$470.00.

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion what held concerning the financial summary. Community Corrections new year begins on July 31-2017.

Currently there at 28 people on Home Detention, 1 on CTP and 8 juveniles at CHANGE Academy. One hundred thirty-four (134) individuals on the Coumminity Service Restitution Program.

Ryan Baker has submitted his resignation from CHANGE Academy.

Kellie state that they do have an Internship Program with Ivy Text for one paid intern, which the position is currently unfilled. There is also an intern position from IPFW, which unpaid, that is not filled.

Discussion was held concerning Work Release. The only information given was “it is moving forward”.

The Pre-Trial Program which is not in operation as of yet was discussed. A sub-committee was formed, Claramary Winebrenner, Mark Olivero and Mayor Yoder.

It was discussed about a Canine Program. Tim Baker has brought his dog, Brownie, with him and he feels that his would be very positive program to implement.
