WHEREAS, H. Charles (Charlie) Winans exhibited his vision and commitment to the community as he helped to establish the first Boy Scout Troop for the disabled, as well as the Wee Haven Center [now called Alliance Industries] for the disabled; and

WHEREAS, H. Charles (Charlie) Winans showed his vision and commitment to the community by serving as the school board attorney for both DeKalb Eastern and Garrett-Keyser-Butler School systems and helped to guide both through building programs; and
