

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-RCC-1

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE LOCAL INCOME TAX
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND TO THE RAINY DAY FUND

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Council adopted Resolution No. 2004-R-3, a Resolution to Establish a Rainy Day Fund Pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-8-5.1, on March 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Indiana statute allows the transfer of any unused funds from any fiscal year to the Rainy Day Fund; and


WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Council has the opportunity to match grant dollars using the Rainy Day Fund; and

WHEREAS, unused funds exist within the Local Income Tax Economic Development Fund.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the DeKalb County Council to transfer \$250,000 from the Local Income Tax Economic Development Fund #1112 to Rainy Day Fund #1186.


