RESOLUTION 2021-RCC-8

A RESOLUTION OF THE DEKALB COUNTY COUNCIL APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF REAL ESTATE FROM THE COUNTY OF DEKALB TO THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA

Under Indiana Code Section 36-1-11-8

whereas, Indiana Code Section 36-1-11-8 states, a transfer or exchange of property may be made with a governmental entity upon terms and conditions agreed upon by the entities as evidenced by adoption of substantially identical Resolutions by each entity. Such a transfer may be made for any amount of real property, cash, or other personal property, as agreed upon by the entities;

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn desires to acquire the County Highway Department real estate which is directly adjacent to Eckhart Park for the purpose of expanding access, greenway and to provide connectivity with recreational activities within the County of DeKalb and the City of Auburn, Indiana;

WHEREAS, the County desires to transfer real estate and has obtained two (2) appraisals establishing value for said real estate;

WHEREAS, it is mutually beneficial for the County and City to collaborate to transfer said real estate; and,

WHEREAS, DeKalb County agrees to make the transfer of the described real estate in accordance with *Indiana Code 36-1-11-8*:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DEKALB COUNTY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- The City of Auburn hereby accepts the transfer of real estate described in "Exhibit A" from DeKalb County, Indiana, in accordance with Indiana Code Section 36-1-11-8.
- 2. The City of Auburn, Indiana, shall incur the costs associated with recording the transfer of said real estate.
- 3. The City of Auburn, Indiana, shall pay the County of DeKalb \$305,000.00 for the transfer of said real estate.

- 4. The City of Auburn shall pay all costs of closing, recording, and title insurance for said transfer.
- 5. The City of Auburn shall allow the County Highway Department to remain at the property rent free for twenty-four (24) months from the date of closing.
- 6. The County Highway Department shall be responsible for the costs of insuring said real estate and the costs of utilities until vacating the real estate.
- 7. The City of Auburn may use the property, if mutually agreed upon by both city and county, prior to the twenty-four (24) month expiration date.
- 8. Both the City of Auburn and the County of DeKalb make this transfer effective by passing substantially identical Resolutions and shall execute other necessary documents to transfer said real estate and to complete the conditions set forth in the Resolutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DEKALB COUNTY COUNCIL PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 36-1-11-8 THAT: Transfer is made to the City of Auburn of the real estate set forth in "Exhibit A". Said transfer is made for consideration as set out in this Resolution and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in an open meeting of the DeKalb County Council in accordance with Indiana Code 36-1-11-8.
