Introduction:

The DeKalb County Commissioners have decided to renew a space study of the existing and future needs of most all county offices. In doing so, there is a need to make sure the future office space is being utilized in the most efficient manner. This study should evaluate options and consider what is feasible and reasonable concerning the future needs of DeKalb County government The purpose of this request for proposals is to receive information from consulting firms interested in working on this project.

General Information:

The successful firm, in doing the assessment, should gather all relevant data, forecast any future capacities and the associated classifications for both men and women, estimate construction, project, operational, and staffing costs for any future facility or other alternatives and present a final report formally to the public. This would of course require looking at various solutions: construction of new facilities or renovation of existing facilities. The county will use the services of a financial advisor to determine tax rates and debt service amounts that would result from each alternative solution in the study that would be used for the public presentation.

Existing Drawings are kept in the Auditor's office for safe keeping and as such please contact the Auditor's office and make an appointment to reference these drawings. The Auditor's office phone number and email is on the DeKalb County Website. Also, if your firm wishes to do a more exact measurement of any given department, please respect the employees and contact the department head before doing so. Each department contact information is listed on the DeKalb County Website. It is also recommended that the winning bid firm talk with each department head to understand the needs of any given department.

An existing list of DeKalb County owned real estate will also be available in the Auditor's office if needed for the study.

Scope of the study:

The scope of services will include but not be limited to the following:

- 1. Evaluate the current buildings and the future needs of the county government. This should include all of the elements: mechanical, electrical, size, configuration, staffing and operational costs.
- 2. Gather data to use and support an analysis to establish the capacity, size, and staffing for any future buildings.
- 3. Establish construction, project, staffing and operational costs for each option presented. Operational costs and staffing costs should consider the differentially costs from current costs.
- 4. Include a schedule of design and construction by duration for each alternate presented.
- 5. Prepare the final report and anticipate presenting this to the public.
- 6. How long will the study take to complete?
