MATTER OF EXECUTIVE SESSION

MATTER OF JAIL COMMITTEE

Elevatus presented the most up-to-date drawings of the proposed jail. There was discussion about various spaces and whether they should be modified. An outside rendering was also presented.

Commissioner Watson brought up the financial aspect of the jail. President Hartman interjected and said we have already discussed financials, and this meeting was to discuss designs. If we are going to talk about financials, it should be in a separate meeting. Commissioner Watson really felt that it is important to talk about the interest rates and their expected increases in 2022 and 2023 by the feds. He said a 1% increase in interest rates will cost the County a little more than \$3 million just in interest on the project. Commissioner Sanderson said when interest rates increase, there will be people begging to do this work and slash their prices, which will counter the increase in cost of interest. President Hartman agreed to discuss financials in a separate meeting.
