On-Site Sewage Treatment System Permit Procedures

- Step 1. The Property Owner or Agent will complete and submit a Residential On-Site Sewage Treatment System Permit Application Form.
- Step 2. An on-site evaluation must be completed by an Indiana Registered Soil Scientist listed with the Indiana Registry of Soil Scientists (IRSS) and a copy sent to the Property Owner or Agent and to the DeKalb County Health Department (DCHD) for review. The DCHD can provide a list of registered soil scientists who work in the DeKalb County area. The DCHD can be present on-site for the soil evaluation if arrangements are made in advance.
- Step 3. Once the soil evaluation and application form are received, the DCHD will determine the minimum requirements for the type, size, and design parameters of the septic system, taking the soils information, a site evaluation, and the permit application information into consideration. The DCHD will then contact the Property Owner or Agent with the specifications for the system that is appropriate for the site according to the Indiana State Department of Health Rule 410 IAC 6-8.3.
- **Any types of systems not described in ISDH Rule 410 IAC 6-8.3 will be subject to ISDH approval prior to DCHD permit issuance unless plan review has been delegated by the ISDH to the DCHD.**
- Step 4. Using the specifications for the appropriate system, the Property Owner or Agent will then submit a scale drawing of the Site-Plan to the DCHD for review. A Site-Plan Review Check List (listing all the requirements of a site-plan drawing) is available at the DCHD
- Step 5. The Site-Plan review will be completed and the plan approved or denied within 45 days (as per IC 16-41-25-1) of the drawing submittal. The DCHD will contact the Property Owner or Agent with the results. If denied, the Property Owner or Agent will be notified in writing of the basis of the denial. Additions and/or corrections can be made and resubmitted for plan approval. When the Site-Plan is approved, the Acceptance of Approved Plan Agreement must be signed by all required parties and returned to the DCHD before a permit can be issued. A \$60.00 Septic Permit Fee will be due at that time. Once paid, a permit will be issued (a copy of the permit needs to be displayed and weather protected on-site) and installation may begin as weather permits. (See Acceptance of Approved Plan for On Site Sewage Treatment System form for wetness test details).
- Step 6. Depending on the type of system being installed and the specific challenges of a site, several inspections points may be required during installation. It is the Property Owner's or Agent's responsibility to be aware of the required inspection points (through close communication with this department) and notify the DCHD accordingly. Once the system has been installed, a final inspection is required before any part of the system may be covered. The Property Owner or Agent will need to contact the DCHD to set an appointment for the Final Approval Inspection. If all requirements are met in the inspection, the system will be approved and may be appropriately covered. The Final Approval section of the permit will be signed and the original permit retained by the DCHD. Copies can be made available to the Property Owner or Agent.
