

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-OCC-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DEKALB COUNTY COUNCIL
CONCERNING FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP'S 2023 BUDGET

WHEREAS Indiana Code 36-1-3 et seq. permits any county in the State of Indiana to exercise any power or perform any function necessary to the public interest in the context of its county or internal affairs, which is not prohibited by the Constitution of the United States or of the State of Indiana, or denied or pre-empted by any other law, or is not expressly granted by any other law to another governmental entity;

WHEREAS the DeKalb County Council is the fiscal body for the County of DeKalb Indiana;

WHEREAS Indiana Code 36-1-23 et seq. provides that in certain circumstances a unit's most recent annual appropriations are continued for the ensuing budget year but that the executive of the unit may petition the county fiscal body for an increase in the unit's budget and property tax levies;

WHEREAS the DeKalb County Council has received a Petition from the Fairfield Township Trustee requesting an increase in Fairfield Township's budget and property tax levies;

WHEREAS Indiana Code 36-1-23 et seq. provides that the county fiscal body may grant or deny the petition only after conducting a public hearing on the petition;

WHEREAS the DeKalb County Council has on this date conducted a public hearing on the Petition pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-23 et seq. after legal advertisement of the public hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ESTABLISHED, RESOLVED, AND ORDAINED by the DeKalb County Council as follows:

1. That the Petition submitted by Fairfield Township regarding its 2023 budget pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-23 is hereby approved and granted.
2. That the increase in Fairfield Township's budget and property tax levies as provided in the proposed budget submitted by Fairfield Township with its Petition is hereby approved and granted.
3. That this Ordinance is effective upon its adoption.
