MATTER OF HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

Emily Engel, county nurse, presented an application and papers on new assistant county nurse Tamara McMaken. Emily would like to waive the 80% reduction of salary. Tamara and family are covered by her husband's health insurance. Don Kaufman motioned to approve application for employment of Tamara McMaken to the DeKalb County Health Department, as Assistant Public Health Nurse and to waive the 90 day 80% salary reduction, Connie Miles second and all approved.

MATTER OF TAX BILLS:

Sue Bauermeister discussed the collection of property taxes, due to the fact the tax rates will be later, tax bills are going out late. John Fetters and Sue discussed the local advertising of voluntary payments of last year's 2005 pay 2006 spring payment that can be used to make 2006 pay 2007 payment that will be adjusted on 2006 pay 2007 fall tax statement.
