

FIGURE YOUR OWN ARREARAGE WORKSHEET

Use this form to figure the arrearage on your case yourself. Your other options for finding your arrearage are to ask your Caseworker in the Child Support Prosecutors Office only if your case is handled by their office or you can have your attorney or Legal Aid figure it for you.

STEP 1: Count the number of Fridays* that have passed since the first payment was due

STEP 2: Multiply the number of Fridays in step one by the current support weekly payment amount# that corresponds with those dates.

STEP 3: Add up the amount that was actually paid
- Enter here _____

STEP 4: Subtract the amount in STEP 3 from the amount in STEP 2
= Enter here _____

***THE AMOUNT IN STEP 4 IS THE
AMOUNT OF ARREARAGE THAT
REMAINS ON THE CASE***

IF THE AMOUNT IN STEP 3 IS GREATER THAN THE AMOUNT IN STEP 2, THERE HAS BEEN AN OVERPAYMENT

(Example)

	52 Fridays
x	<u>\$100 per week</u>
	\$5200 owed
-	<u>\$5000 paid</u>
	\$200 arrearage

* 52 Fridays per year except for 1965, 1971, 1976, 1982, 1988, 1993, 1999, 2004, 2010, 2016, 2021, 2027, 2032, 2038, 2044 which have 53 Fridays

do not add your weekly arrearage amount.

*** Add the amount of arrearage that were ordered by the court when the ongoing child support order was entered by the court to the total arrearage above.
