Wilhelm faithfully served the citizens of DeKalb County beginning in 1938 as a Clerk Stenographer for the Welfare Department; and later served as a Clerk and then First Deputy Clerk in the Auditor's Office, and was eventually elected as DeKalb County Auditor from 1983 to 1986, electing not to run again due to a medical issue. She also worked part time during later years in the Assessor's office and Treasurer's office; and

**WHEREAS**, Wilma C. Wilhelm was an active member of the DeKalb County Republican Women during her years in County government, dedicated member of her church, as well as the Auburn Homemakers Extension Club and the Red Hat Society; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of this County are indebted to Wilma C. Wilhelm for her unselfish leadership and service to our community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the DeKalb County Commissioners commemorate the life of Wilma C. Wilhelm; and acknowledge that in her passing, our community has lost a faithful and valued servant; and express our gratitude and respect for her unselfish public service.




